JETBLUE SERVICE TO BIG APPLE FROM DAYTONA BEACH STARTS JANUARY 7 -- New York-based carrier JetBlue last week announced the start of direct service between Daytona Beach and John F. GAS PRICES DOWN; TRAVEL UP -- According to AAA, gasoline prices for the July 4th holiday were the lowest since 2009, and more Americans than ever took to the road. Lower prices have helped Americans save about \$65 billion on gas (more than \$530 for each U.S. household) in the first six months of 2015. U.S. Energy Information predicts that average gasoline prices nationwide will decline for the rest of the year to an average of \$2.43 per gallon in the second half of 2015.
