WORKSHOP ON DOING BUSINESS WITH VOLUSIA COUNTY – Volusia County's Purchasing and Contracts Division will hold two workshops for business vendors who want to learn how to do business with the county. The workshops will be held in the first floor training room of the Thomas C. Kelly Administration Center, 123 W. Indiana Ave., DeLand, at 5:30 p.m. Wednesday, Nov. 13, and 9 a.m. Thursday, Nov. 14. County representatives will demonstrate how to register as a vendor; explain how to submit bids, proposals and quotes; and discuss applicable state and local ordinances. Staff will explain the information channels available to vendors and answer questions. This three-day festival will draw nearly 10,000 local students to experience what STEM is all about. Nov. 7 and 8 are open to school field trips from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. On Nov. 9, STEMFEST will open to the general public from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. and feature the 2019 MultiGP Drone Racing Championships. Tickets for Saturday can be purchased at the gate. Students under 18 are free with a \$10 paid adult admission. <u>STEMFEST</u> features numerous exhibitors providing hands-on activities, live performances, interactive demonstrations and family-oriented STEM entertainment.
