



Volusia, FL & U.S. Private Industry Annual Average Wage Trends




Florida Counties with Above State Average Annual Wage




Regional Average Annual Wage Comparison



Volusia County Private Employment and Average Annual Wage by Industry Super Sector





Volusia County Business Establishments and Average Annual Wage by Industry Super Sector





Volusia County Available Labor Force and Employed Trend








Employment by Major Industry Deltona-Daytona-Ormond MSA (includes Flagler County)





Volusia County Commercial New Construction Building Permits












2021-2022 High School, Post-Secondary and Associate Degree Completions
